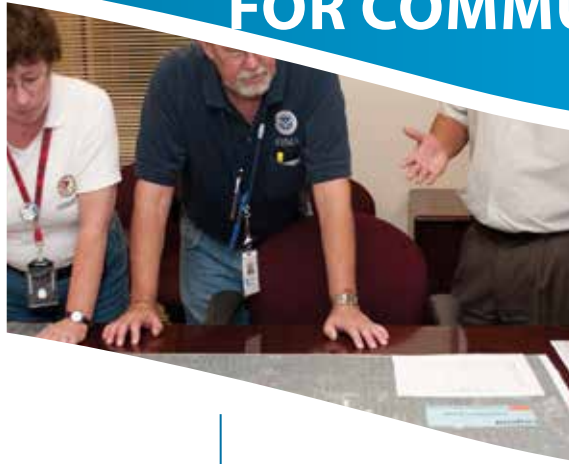


NATURAL DISASTER AWARENESS FOR COMMUNITY LEADERS

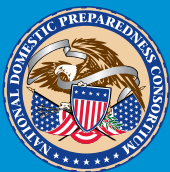
