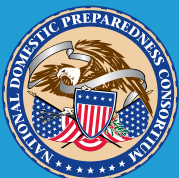
The Kern EOC is located in a secure county compound. The nearest intersection is Panorama Drive and Mt. Vernon Avenue. (The EOC is NOT the white building on the corner). Traveling east on Panorama, immediately after passing Mt. Vernon is a right-turn lane, which turns into the driveway to the compound. Directly ahead are two gates with up/down arms. Press "5" at the gate keypad for entry. When the gate arm lifts, a sliding gate on the left will simultaneously open. Turn left, driving past the sliding gate into the compound parking lot. The EOC is the building to the right.
